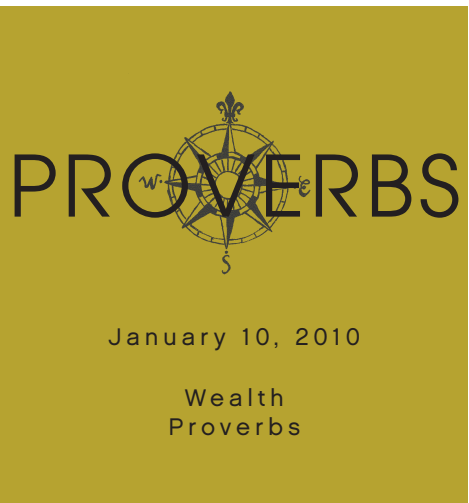

SERMON NOTES - WEALTH - PROVERBS

Most of us hear ‘wealth’ and we think of a rich old man who lives in a mansion, or we think of a rich young European who just wrecked his third Ferrari. When we hear ‘wealth’ we think, ‘Not me.’ However, the Biblical view of wealth is much broader – in the Scriptures we all have wealth because we all have received blessings from God. So the question is not whether we have wealth (we do) but how we use our wealth.

Proverbs is filled with wisdom on wealth: how to get it and how to use it.

WEALTH IS A GIFT FROM GOD (ECCLESIASTES 5:19; PROVERBS 1:7; 22:4)

FOUR TYPES OF STEWARDS

Righteous Rich – *Marked by contentment, hard work and faithfulness (Proverbs 8:18-21; 15:6)*

Righteous Poor – *Marked by contentment, hard work and honesty (Proverbs 28:6; Luke 21:1-4)*

Unrighteous Rich – *Marked by greed, lying and stealing (Proverbs 11:16-18; 11:7)*

Unrighteous Poor – *Marked by greed, laziness and complacency (Proverbs 6:10-11; 20:4; 28:10)*

A GOOD STEWARD IS DILIGENT (PROVERBS 21:5)

GOOD PLANNING (PROVERBS 14:22)

HARD WORK (PROVERBS 28:20; 10:4)

LITTLE BY LITTLE (PROVERBS 13:11)

A GOOD STEWARD HONORS THE LORD BY GIVING (PROVERBS 3:9)

GIVE AS A MATTER OF PRIORITY (DEUTERONOMY 26:8-10)

GIVE AS A MATTER OF SACRIFICE (2 SAMUEL 24:24)

GIVE ALSO TO THE POOR (PROVERBS 14:31; 19:17; 21:13)

A GOOD STEWARD DOESN'T PLAY GAMES WITH GOD (PROVERBS 13:17)

DON'T PRETEND TO BE RICH (ROMANS 12:3)

DON'T PRETEND TO BE POOR (HAGGAI 1:2-4)
