SERMON NOTES - SEX - PROVERBS 5

DRINK THE WATER: PURSUE PLEASURE WITH YOUR SPOUSE (PROVERBS 5:15-19)

SINGLE-MINDED DEVOTION (PROVERBS 5:15-17)

SATISFYING DEVOTION (PROVERBS 5:18-19)

Questions to ask yourself if you're single:

- Are you preparing yourself to be a spouse of single-minded devotion?
- Are you guarding your eyes, heart and mind today in anticipation of giving yourself exclusively to your spouse in the future?
- Men are you a player? Do you flirt with women to use them sexually?
- Women does your dress and the way you carry yourself attempt to allure men sexually?

Questions to ask yourself if you're married:

- Do you think of your spouse as a gift of God custom built just for you?
- Do you pray for your spouse? Do you pray with your spouse?
- Do you dwell on their good qualities? Complement them often?
- Do you treat your spouse as you treat yourself?
- Are you cheerful around your spouse or grumpy?
- Do you seek to make time just to be with them?
- When was the last time that you surprised them with a special gift?
- Do you give them affectionate hugs and kisses?
- Are you working to be a handsome husband for them?
- Are you still chasing [dating] your spouse?
- Do you check-in with them during the day?

FLEE THE FIRE: BEWARE OF THE RUIN OF ADULTERY

THIS FIRE LURES YOU IN (PROVERBS 5:1-3)

THIS FIRE TAKES YOUR HONOR (PROVERBS 5:5-10)

THIS FIRE BRINGS UTTER RUIN (PROVERBS 5:11-15)

THIS FIRE IS BEFORE THE EYES OF THE LORD (PROVERBS 5:20-21)

Reflect on the ruin of sexual sin and adultery

- Dragging Christ's reputation through the mud.
- Having to look Jesus in the face at the judgment seat one day and explain why you did it.
- Untold hurt to your spouse/future spouse.
- Shame to your family.
- Shame to your church and friends.
- Bringing great pleasure to Satan, God's enemy.
- Possibly contracting an STD or causing a pregnancy.
- Loss of self-respect, discrediting your own name and invoking shame on yourself.

RETURNING TO GOD

- PRAY AND ADMIT YOUR SIN TO GOD.
- BELIEVE THAT GOD SENT JESUS TO DIE IN YOUR PLACE TO OVERCOME THE RUIN THIS SIN CREATED.
- PRAY AND MAKE YOUR DEPENDENCE ON GOD CLEAR BY ASKING FOR THE HOLY SPIRIT'S HELP.
- TAKE STEPS TO DRINK THE WATER AND FLEE THE FIRE
