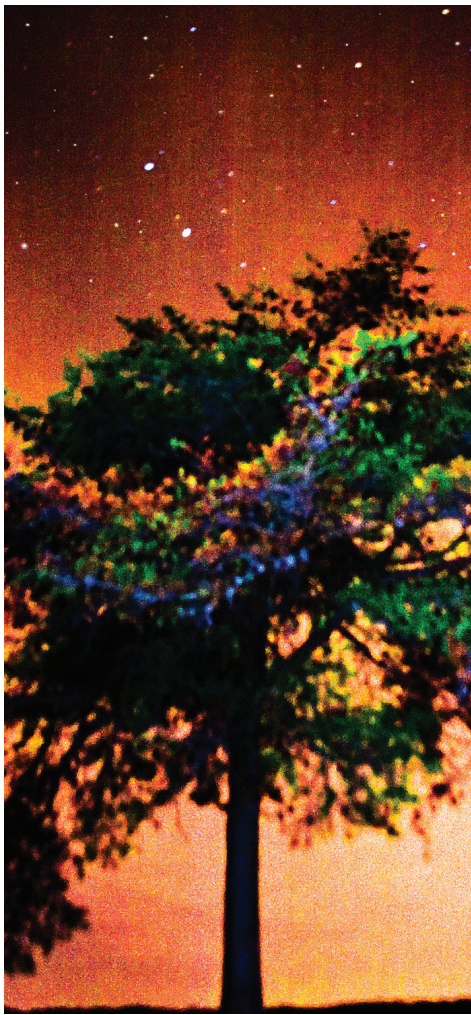

Who is like God? Certainly not the people or leaders of Israel in Micah's day. The people devoted themselves completely to their own self-interest through cheating and swindling. The leaders, in turn, used the people to serve themselves. In short, instead of loving God and loving people, everybody was ignoring God and abusing people. Micah speaks truth into the situation, astutely calling the people and the leaders out for their failure and declaring God's judgment. He doesn't leave it there, though. Micah points forward to a future leader, a Shepherd King, who was on his way and would rule where generations of rulers had fallen short and would make peace between God and the people. Into injustice and judgment, Micah proclaimed hope.
