LIFE IS NOT FULLY EXPERIENCED IF IT'S NOT SHARED WITH CLOSE FRIENDS (ECCLESIASTES 4:9-12)

We were created to experience life in a small community of close friends. The Scriptures clearly call us to pursue close friendships. The friendship of fellow Christians empowers us to grow and advance God's mission in ways that would be impossible for us alone.

GOOD FRIENDS GIVE HEARTFELT COUNSEL (PROVERBS 27:9)

GOOD FRIENDS DON'T BAIL IN TIME OF NEED (PROVERBS 17:17)

GOOD FRIENDS MAKE YOU BETTER (PROVERBS 27:17)
