
Responsibilities

- Establishes, maintains and reviews all medical, security and safety policies and procedures.
- Maintains a working knowledge of all reported incidents and prevention.
- Recruits, equips, and leads all Safety and Medical Team coordinators and members.
- Aids the Operations Director in providing leadership and direction to Sojourn Midtown staff as it pertains to safety and security.

Character and Competencies

- Fulfills the character and qualifications of a member as outlined in the Sojourn Bylaws and membership covenant.
- Affirms the dignity of others; exemplifies a posture of humility, kindness, and love.
- Strong knowledge and skill in the area of safety and security.
- Ability to recruit, train, communicate with, and direct teams.
- Possesses moderate administrative skills for the purpose of coordinating, scheduling, and communicating.

- Is a member of Sojourn Midtown and adheres to Member Covenant
- Establishes consistent communication, meetings, and training with team coordinators and members to ensure each SERT team member is properly equipped for their role.
- Supports the mission and goals of Sojourn Midtown and remains aligned with the Mercy Ministry philosophy and values.
- Commitment to collaborate with the Operations Director, including a monthly meeting.
- Regularly pursues ongoing learning and equipping as it pertains to church safety and security.
